ANNUAL CONFERENCE


- The Annual Conference is held in June of every year.

TRUSTEE SCHOOLS

- Held twice a year, Winter and Fall.
- **CPPT Program Sessions** are split into Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced. Attendee will remain the same room over the course of two days of learning and will be required to complete an exam on the third day.
- **CEU Program Sessions** are designed mainly for attendees who have already complete the CPPT Program. Attendees can pick and choose which sessions they would like to attend based on interest or need.
- Certificate Programs for more experienced trustees, we offer certificate programs which are full day sessions that take a deep dive on one aspect of the pension world (ie. legal, actuarial, investment management, etc). Participants receive a certificate of completion for participating in these programs.

CERTIFIED PUBLIC PENSION TRUSTEE (CPPT) PROGRAM

The FPPTA launched the Certified Public Pension Trustee (CPPT) program in 1997. The goal of the CPPT program is to prepare trustees to perform their duties with confidence and expertise, and to instill in them the value of continuing education in an ever-changing landscape.

- At Trustee Schools you may pick and choose which sessions you'd like to attend based on need or interest.


