

- ANDREA FARAH is a senior associate who focuses her practice on securities fraud, commodities manipulation, and antitrust litigation. Her most recent achievements include work on *In re GSE Bonds Antitrust Litigation*, No. 19-cv-1704 (S.D.N.Y.) (price fixing conspiracy in the bond market, which settled for \$386.5 million) and *Lopez v. Apple, Inc.*, No. 19-cv-4577 (N.D. Cal.) (brought on behalf of consumers which settled for \$95 million). Ms. Farah leads the securities monitoring team for Lowey and identifies securities litigation opportunities for public and private investors and institutional clients.
- Ms. Farah has litigated prominent securities cases with novel and complex claims relating to a variety of financial instruments, including *In re FireEye, Inc. Sec. Litig.*, No. 14-cv-266866 (Cal. Super. Ct.) (\$10.25 million settlement); *Birmingham Ret. and Relief Sys. v. S.A.C. Capital Advisors, L.P.*, No. 13-cv-2459 (S.D.N.Y.) (\$10 million settlement), as well as several consumer cases involving financial products which achieved large recoveries for consumers, including among others *Murr v. Capital One Bank (USA), N.A.*, No. 13-cv-1091 (E.D. Va.) (\$75 million settlement, alleging consumer fraud in connection with the company's offer of zero percent APR); *Valle v. Popular Community Bank*, No. 653936/12 (N.Y. Sup. Ct.) (\$8 million settlement, alleging unfair business practices with respect to the bank's practice of imposing overdraft fees).
- Ms. Farah is a graduate of the Quinnipiac University School of Law (J.D., *cum laude*, 2013) and the School of Business (M.B.A, 2013). Ms. Farah is licensed to practice in the States of New York and Connecticut and is admitted to various federal and state courts across the country. Ms. Farah is bilingual and maintains a *pro bono* practice in the area of immigration law.
