- Index Replication -Portfolio designed to mirror a market index
- Market-Weighted Allocations Larger companies get larger allocations
- Earnings-Based Holdings? -No
- Sell After Poor Earnings? No
- Sell After Fraud or Weak Outlook? -No

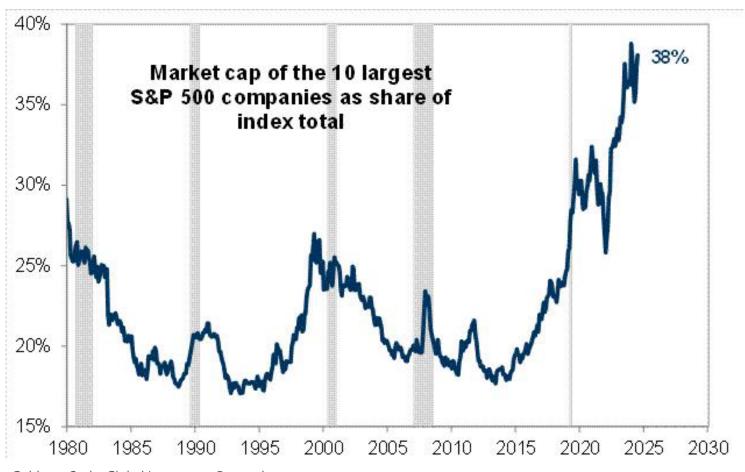

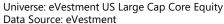
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Historical Cycles Repeat

- The index performs poorly in volatile markets



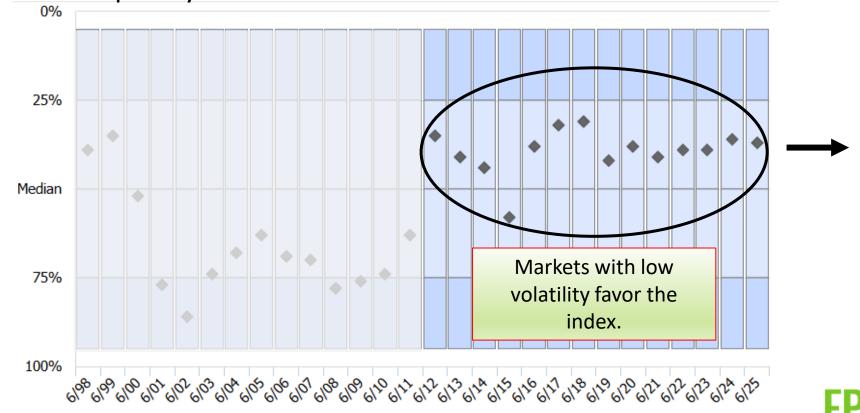
